# Historic Registration & Log Books

## Eyewatch – Victoria

The following report was published by Victoria Police on their Eyewatch Facebook page recently. Eyewatch is a Police social media initiative providing an information channel between Police and the community. While the rules are a little different in each of the various State & Territory jurisdictions, this report serves as a warning and reminder for all members with vehicles on Concessional or Historic registration to ensure that their membership and their vehicle’s Log Book is maintained diligently.

### **Eyewatch: Club Reg infringement**

Yesterday (12/11/18) was perfect weather to go out for a cruise, unfortunately the driver of a 1964 MG Roadster forgot to keep it under control. He was intercepted after he was detected travelling at 77km/h in a 60 zone on Beaconsfield-Emerald Road, Guys Hill.

The driver had also failed to fill in his club registration log book which therefore makes the vehicle unregistered. The driver told police that he fills the book in when he gets to his destination. The conditions of the club registration clearly state that it must be completed BEFORE you start your journey. An important reminder for all motorists with a club registration.

The driver on this occasion was issued a total of \$1128 of infringement notices for speeding and driving an unregistered vehicle.

## Calendar Girls



### 2013 Toyota 86

The Toyota motor co Ltd was formed in 1937, after detaching itself from the Toyota Automatic Loom Works, which was world famous as the maker of Power Looms & Spinning machines. In 1959 Toyota City covered 520 acres & had a monthly output capacity of 10,000 units.

The Toyota 86 was 1st presented at the Detroit motor show in 2007 & was powered by a V6 rear wheel drive configuration. In 2008 Toyota bought 16.5% of Fuji Heavy industries which gave it access to Subaru. This allowed the badge engineering of the Subaru BRZ & the Toyota 86 using Subaru mechanicals, & assembly at Subaru's Gunma plant.

The 86 has been awarded Car of the Year in 5 countries, performance car, best drivers car & top safety package from motor scribes worldwide.

It is now providing spectacular racing in the Toyota 86 Pro-am series in Aust, (& elsewhere around the globe).

## 1966 Humber Sceptre

If in the early 1960s you wanted to replace your early post-war (or pre-war) motoring appliance, but didn't fancy one of the big three but requiring something of similar size, the selection wasn't all that large.

One way was to look at BMC (Morris, Wolesley, Austin), or European (Peugeot, Fiats, Renault) etc, remembering that Japan hadn't really made any inroads yet.

Rootes group Hillman Super Minx, Singer Vogue, (Humber vogue) range. Sturdy, reasonably powered (85 mph), 4spd, (or Auto if required), room for 5/6 passengers, 30 mpg plus they were cheaper than 6cyl vehicles of similar specifications, in addition to being robust.

In Ol Blighty a couple years after the release of the 1st two, the Humber Sceptre was released as an up market version (spelling the end of the 4cyl Humber Hawk). It had a restyled front, different roof line & double-- fin rear treatment. Mechanically they received very much the same motor/ gearbox as the Sunbeam Alpine, in other words, a sports car in a sedan shell.

Very few of these models were imported into Australia, & this fine example is one of ,if not the best.
