MID-WEEK RUN REPORT – 12 MAY 2021 – HOWLONG/JINGELLIC

Midweek Wednesday Run to Jingellic

Just another day in Paradise!

Just for a change, we met on the Causeway for our monthly run where Malcolm marked the roll and distributed his beautiful maps. These maps will surely become collectors' items, carefully prepared and in full colour and its worth noting that nobody has ever won the "Find the Fault" after much scrutiny of many maps over many months!

We set off along the well-known track, north along the freeway then along the Olympic Highway to Culcairn before heading east to Holbrook for coffee at the Caltex truck stop. They are always well prepared there, very accommodating and a great range of pies, cakes and Jenny Craig's with good quality coffee and lots of good conversation.



After Holbrook, the final leg took us through Wantagong and Lankeys Creek before hitting the pub at Jingellic, a 45 minute drive from Holbrook providing off-highway travel with very scenic views and a few gentle bends along the way. Probably a little too gentle for Peter S and just about right for Noel and Maria.

The pub itself hasn't changed for years apart from a number of "freshen-ups" over the years and the view from the dining room remains to-die-for looking over a small expanse of the Mighty Murray. Between the beer garden and the river, there is a beautiful, grassy expanse that is a designated free-camping area and it's a very popular spot for campers and families on a picnic. The pub boasts a very congenial main bar with an open fire and a separate dining room overlooking the river. We enjoyed excellent service and top-quality pub meals and a busy, open kitchen ensured the speedy delivery of food.

The town was settled via land grants in the 1830s and 1840s and the Post Office opened in 1883. As late as 1920, a butter factory was established and closed in 1963.

Looking over to the east, the remains of the old bridge are clearly visible – it was opened in 1892 along with a Customs House on the Victorian side of the river.

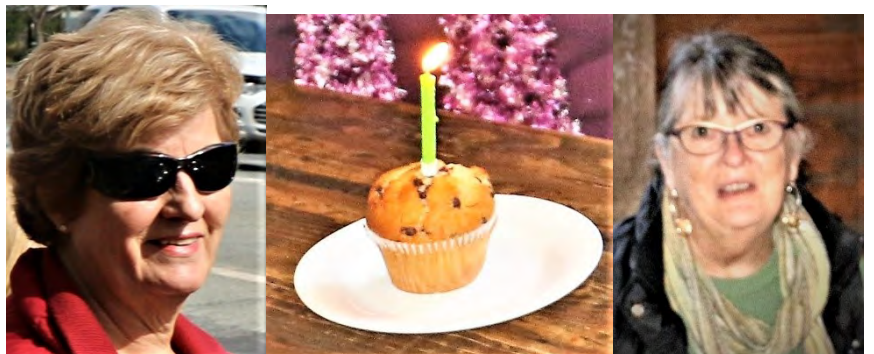
Cuisine at the Hotel was excellent, as always, and the R.S.C.A. were most appreciative of the service.

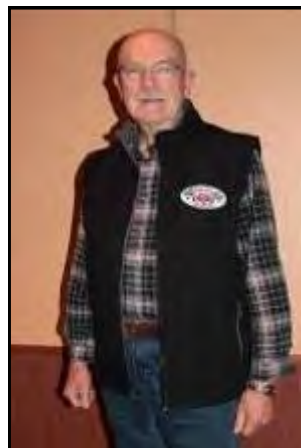

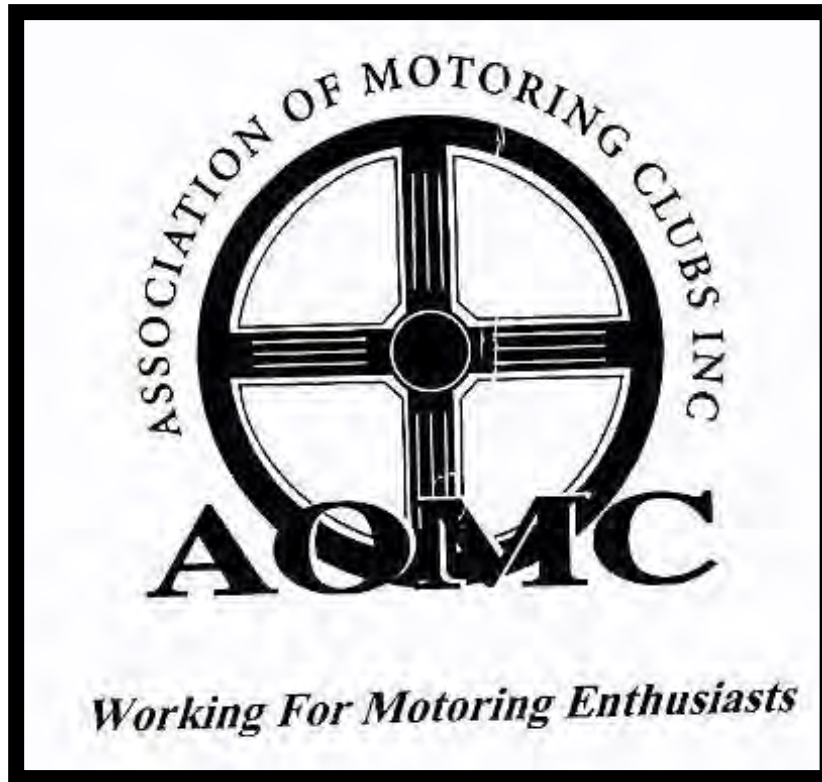
